HALL OF FAME

The HALL OF FAME in the Niagara area is to honor, pay tribute and perpetuate the names of the members who have contributed to the growth and welfare of tenpin bowling in our association through their bowling achievements or meritorious service, even if posthumously.

ARTICLE 1: The Name

The name shall be established as the Niagara Tenpin Bowling Association Hall of Fame, and shall be referred to hereafter as The Hall of Fame.

ARTICLE 2: The Categories

There shall be two categories under which a person may be nominated to The Hall of Fame:

- 1. Distinguished performance
- 2. Meritorious service

ARTICLE 3: Eligibility Requirements

- Election to the Hall of Fame in either category shall be open to any individual who is now or has been a member in good standing of Niagara's sanctioned bowling associations and has met the requirements set out in these regulations.
- 2. To be eligible for induction to the Hall of Fame, a nominee must have a minimum of 20 years in adult sanctioned leagues in the Niagara TBA. They must have participated in 10 local tournaments (not necessarily consecutive) over the 20-year period
- 3. A candidate must be a person who has demonstrated outstanding service, devotion and ideals over many years of involvement in tenpin bowling. These contributions must be more that the normal achievements of the game. A person who is now or ever was under suspension by a sanctioning organization (i.e. CTF, OTBA, and USBC) is ineligible.

NOMINATIONS

Nomination to the Hall of Fame may be made by any member of the Niagara Tenpin Bowling Association who is in good standing. The nomination must be made on a Hall of Fame nomination form together with a resume of the achievements of the nominee to any member of the Hall of Fame committee. One nomination per year per person is allowed. If the nominee is not accepted the application shall be retained for two voting years. After three election years, names must be resubmitted. A majority of The Hall of Fame committee must be in favor of the nominee.

The deadline for nominations and resume is January 15,2024
