#### **Tournament Rules**

- 1) This tournament is open to all ten pin bowlers. It is a sanctioned tournament (you will bowl 4 games across 8 lanes)
  - 2) This is a singles event. (open to men & women entries)
- 3) Entrants will use their highest current CTF or USBC sanctioned average (minimum of 21 games) unless you have a higher average sanctioned from the past bowling season.

  (the 2022 / 2023 bowling season)

(bowlers without a current sanctioned average as well as an sanctioned average from the past bowling season must report this to the tournament official's for a possible adjustment of your handicap)

(Sports league averages not accepted) - (Summer League averages not accepted)
(Sanctioned Youth League averages may be adjusted accordingly)
All bowlers cashing in the tournament must supply the tournament directors with your League secretaries written verification of your entering average.

4) Bowlers from outside the Niagara Region must have either an USBC, or CTF sanctioned book average from this year as well as the 2022 / 2023 bowling season.

If you cash in the tournament you must also supply the tournament directors with your league secretaries written verification of your entering average's prior to receiving your winnings.

- 5) You may bowl in both shifts of the tournament but cash only once in the same division. You must declare which division you are bowling in (Scratch or Handicap Division) on your entry form before the start of bowling.
   If your entering average exceeds 230 you can only bowl in the scratch division
- 6) All monies will be paid out 7 days following the completion of the tournament and after all cashing averages are verified.
  - \*\* 7 days after the completion of the tournament all results become final \*\* (pending average verifications)
  - 7) The tournament directors will have the right to accept or reject all entries and will decide all questions and disputes THEIR DECISION WILL BE FINAL.
    - 8) Handicap: each entries handicap will be 90 % of the difference of your entering average and 230 per game.

If your entering average exceeds 230 you must bowl in the scratch division.

9) Brackets & Side pots available on the day of the tournament.
